The following are some of the clauses in our constitution that forms part of the guidelines for the management of funds and assets of the church:

“The Pastor and the assistant pastor/s shall lead a Christ like life, complying with the Biblical doctrines espoused, including, without limitation, regarding sexual morality, good financial stewardship/management, morality, the standards required by 1 Timothy 3, the Code of Conduct and the Statement of Faith (“the Standard”).” – Clause 10.3

“The Finance Committee shall act under the direction and authority of the Advisory Board in managing the Local Church’s day-to-day financial affairs, including, without limitation, the preparation of financial statements (audited and unaudited), monthly management accounts and the presentation thereof to the Advisory Board, but otherwise the Finance Committee shall be self-regulated.” – Clause 13.5
